

One of the easiest and most important things you can do to protect your property is to document what you own. In addition to recording serial numbers, descriptions and projected values, it is a good idea to photograph or take video of your possessions as proof of ownership. Get a professional appraisal of valuable items such as artwork, jewelry and antiques. Tip: There is no need to list every single item you own, but at least record the items of significant value. Update your inventory on a yearly basis.

Entryway / foyer – Don't forget to include special fixtures, lighting, accessories, rugs, window coverings, etc.				
Living room – Start with the most expensive items in the room and work backwards. Don't forget TV streaming devices, game consoles and other hardware that would need to be replaced in case of a total home loss.

Dining room / pantry – Get appraisals on potentially valuable hand-me-down items such as dishware and antiques to make sure they are adequately covered.				
Kitchen – Don't overlook small kitchen electronics and any larger appliances that you own (don't include appliances owned by your landlord if you are renting).
